SPORTS POLICY



PREAMBLE

To participate in sports activities is the right of every child irrespective of race, gender, religion, and physical state. Sports provide opportunities for the acquisition of comprehensive knowledge, attitude, and skills which stimulate individual and group consciousness.

Therefore, the Sports Policy of Guru Kashi University is designed as a functional program for the promotion of the educational, physical, and psychological health of the sportspersons, to equip them with the appropriate skills, abilities as well as physical and mental competencies to live in and contribute meaningfully to the development of the society.

With the implementation of the Sports Policy of Guru Kashi University, the University envisions its student-athletes bringing laurels at various National and International stages.

GURU KASHI UNIVERSITY SPORTS COMMITTEE

Constitution, objectives, and functions of the Guru Kashi University Sports Committee (GKU SC)

Objectives

The policy will focus to:

1. organize and regulate sports activities.
2. promote team spirit and sportsmanship among the university players.
3. conduct tournaments annually in various games.

GKU SC shall consist of:

| 5. Director Students' Welfare | Ex. Officio Member |
| 6. Director Sports | Ex. Officio Secretary |
| 7. HOD /Senior Most Faculty Member (Phy.Edu.) | Ex. Officio Joint Secretary |

Functions and powers of the Sports Committee

1. To frame rules for the organization of the Sports Committee and conduct of competitions.
2. To give decisions on any point not covered by the rules and approve the recommendations of executive committee.
3. To select the President, Vice President, and Twelve members of the Executive Committee.
4. To appoint committees for the selection of university teams.
5. To encourage the HODs of individual colleges of GKU to send teams to the university tournaments.

6. The annual general meeting of the GKU SC shall be convened in July every year to select the new Executive Committee.
7. To adopt the Annual Report of the events conducted and activities done by the Sports Committee of GKU.
8. To amend the rules or frame new rules or bye-laws as required.
9. To approve the Annual Sports Calendar of the university.
10. If the new Executive Committee is not constituted in the Annual General Meeting, the Vice Chancellor may permit the existing Executive Committee to function till the new committee has been constituted.
11. The quorum for the General Body Meeting of GKU SC will be 1/4th of the total membership of the exiting Sports Committee.

Office bearers of the Executive Committee

1. President
2. Vice President
3. Members of individual colleges of GKU college (Twelve Members)
4. Secretary (Director Sports)
5. Joint Secretary (HOD/ Senior Faculty of Department of Physical Education)

President

The President of the GKU SC will be selected from the Senior Officials or Deans of the teaching departments for a term of one year on a seniority basis. It will be on a rotation basis among the Senior Authorities or Deans of individual colleges of GKU.

Vice-President

The Vice-President will be selected among the Deans/HODs of individual colleges of GKU on a seniority basis. It will also be on a rotation basis for a term of one year.

Members

Twelve members of the Sports Committee will be nominated by the Deans from the teaching faculty of their respective College for a term of one year, provided that there is only one member from each college in the Sports Committee.

Secretary

The Director of Sports will be the ex-officio Secretary of the GKU SC.

Joint Secretary

HOD/ Senior Most Faculty members of the Physical Education Department will be the Joint Secretary of GKU SC.

Duties and Powers of the President

- 1) The President will be the Chairman of the Sports Committee.
- 2) To Preside Over the meetings of the Executive Committee.
- 3) In the case of voting, the President shall have a casting vote.
- 4) In case of emergency, for any decision to be taken/implemented in anticipation. Such a decision will be placed before the Sports Committee in its next meeting for ratification.

Duties and Powers of the Vice-President

- 1) The Vice-President will act as President in the absence of the President.
- 2) The Vice-President will exercise the powers vested in him by the Sports Committee.

Secretary

The functions of the secretary shall be as under:

- 1) To deal with the correspondence on behalf of the GKU SC.
- 2) Implement all the decisions of the GKU SC.
- 3) Convene all the meetings and record their minutes.
- 4) Responsible for the maintenance of all records and property of the GKU SC.
- 5) Carry out all the duties which may be entrusted to him from time to time by the Sports Committee.
- 6) Make payments as per university rules.
- 7) Conduct tournaments and select teams of the University to participate in Inter-University Competitions.

Joint Secretary

The joint secretary will discharge the duties as may be assigned to him by the Secretary /Sports Committee. However, all activities recommended by the executive committee shall be ratified/approved by the sports committee.

Tournaments

Tournaments in the following games given by Ministry of Sports, Govt. of India and some local games will be conducted on annual basis as per the rules of AIU.

Miscellaneous Rules

1. The Department of Sports shall prepare the Inter-College sports calendar on annual basis.
2. Selection of players for the Inter-University team will be done during the Inter-College matches, however, trials will be held to judge the other outstanding players who did not participate in the Inter-College competition.
3. A coaching camp of at least 21 days will be held before the Inter-university competition.
4. No Substandard team will be sent for the Inter-University competitions.
5. Students Participating in the Inter-College, Inter-University, State, National, International, or other such official tournaments will be considered on duty.
6. The special examination will be conducted for the sports persons who will participate in the Inter-University, National, or International Sports Competitions during their exams.
7. The competition will not be held if less than three colleges enter their teams.
8. Each college is allowed to nominate only one team for a tournament.
9. All the matches will be played on a knockout basis.
10. If a team wants to protest it must be communicated to the Director of Sports within an hour.
11. If a team walks off the field of play during the match, it will be disqualified and the match will be awarded to the contesting team.
12. A team walking off the field of play as a protest against the judgment of a Referee shall be deemed to have lost the match.
13. If a sportsperson evades participation in the Inter-University competition, GKU SC will take strict action against a such player(s).
14. Particulars of players must be filled in, on the prescribed eligibility Performa and submitted in the office of the Director Sports in duplicate two days before the competition.

15. Eligibility Performa must be signed by the Dean of the individual college of GKU.
16. A student whose name is not included in the eligibility Performa will not be allowed to participate in the Inter-College matches.
17. Entries must be sent on the prescribed dates as per the schedule of the University mentioned in the sports calendar.
18. A responsible staff member of the department must accompany the team participating in the tournament.
19. Participation in the Annual Athletic Meet is compulsory for all the colleges of the University.
20. All teams will report to the Referee 30 minutes before the start of the match.
21. All players of the Team must be in a proper sports kit to play in the match.
22. No derogatory or offensive remarks will be allowed during the University Matches.
23. In case any member of a university team misbehaves, the matter will be reported by the Manager of the Team to the Director of Sports.
24. Merit Certificates and Medals will be awarded to the teams and individual players as per winning criteria viz. first, Second and third positions in the Inter-College Competitions.
25. University Trophy will be awarded to the college, which wins the overall General Championship in the Inter-College competitions.
26. A Trophy will be awarded to the college which wins the Overall Athletics Championship.
27. Criteria for the Award of General Championship are as follows:
 - A) Points for the team games

1 st Position-	30 points
2 nd Position -	20 points
3 rd Position -	15 points
4 th Position -	10 points
 - B) Points for the individual sports

1 st Position -	05 points
2 nd Position -	03points
3 rd Position -	02 points
4 th Position -	01 points
 - C) Relays, Decathlon, Heptathlon

1 st Position -	10 points
2 nd Position -	06 points
3 rd Position -	04 points
4 th Position -	02 points

28. Rules for the appointment of Captains of University teams will be as follows:

- A) Seniority in Inter-University participation.
- B) Seniority in the class
- C) Level of performance
- D) Seniority in age
- E) Good conduct.

29. Award of University Colour

University color will be awarded annually as per the following criteria.

- A) Position holders in the Senior/Junior National Championships/**International Participants**
- B) Position holders in the All India Inter University Championship/ Khelo India University Games
- C) Best Athlete of the University Annual Athletic Meet.

Uniform to the Players

Two sets of uniforms will be provided to the university players who represent GKU in the Inter-University matches. The uniform includes T-Shirts, shorts, sports shoes, and socks. Besides the uniform, a Track Suit will also be provided to the Participating players.

Financial Incentives to Players, Coaches, and Team Managers.

1. TA/DA to the players and Coaches/Managers will be paid as per the rates given below:

I) Players attending the coaching camp

Rs. 200/- per day per Head

II) Players, Coaches, and Managers representing GKU in the Inter-University competitions. DA will be as under:

For Players:

Below 500 km Rs. 300/- per head/ per day

500 km to 1000 km Rs. 400/- per head/ perday

Above 1000 km Rs. 500/- per head/ per day

For Coaches and Managers:

Below 500km Rs. 400/- per head/ per day

500 km to 1000 km Rs. 500/- per head/ per day

Above 1000 km Rs. 600/- per head/ per day

III) Refreshments to the players on the day of the match Rs. 50/- per player per match

2. Coach/Manager accompanying the GKU teams for participation in the Inter-University Competition will be given incidental charges equal to a

single AC 3-tier fare as an incentive. But they will travel along with the team in 2nd class to maintain discipline among the players.

3. Any player/ team winning a medal will be given a rousing welcome on return to the University campus.
4. A sum of Rs.5000/- will be given to the Best Athlete selected among the boys and girls.
5. In the case of injury during competition/journey/ All India Inter University/North Zone University will give medical allowance as per the bill submitted by Sports Department.

Officiating Charges

TA/ DA and officiating charges to the external officials conducting the university matches will be paid as under:

Rs. 1000/- per day and TA (As per university rules)

Sports Awards/Scholarships

To encourage outstanding Sports Persons to give their best performance in the Inter-University and National Competitions, Incentive in the shape of scholarships as cash awards will be given as under:

5% seats have been reserved in the admission of the university to raise good teams for their participation in the Inter-University Competitions. The scheme is as follows:

SPORTS POLICY FOR ADMISSIONS AND BENEFITS TO SPORTS PERSONS

Guidelines for admission to the reserved category of sports

It is recommended that in 'Guru Kashi University' 5% of the total number of seats in each course be reserved for sports persons. The procedure to be followed is as under:

1. Each candidate will submit photocopies of all the sports certificates along with a photocopy of class 10th, 12th, and eligibility certificates.
2. The Vice-Chancellor shall have the authority to withdraw the benefits if it is found that the candidate has obtained such admission based on a false certificate.
3. Students seeking admission under this category will be considered for admission only in the games included in the 'MAKA' Trophy and Khelo India University Games.
4. Reservation under the sports category is meant only for those active sports persons who would participate in the Inter-College, Inter-University, National, and Inter-National Level Sports tournaments. Such students will be considered for admission only if: -
 - a) Their achievement in sports is related to the activities in any of the two years immediately preceding the years of admission.
 - b) They are eligible for participation in Inter-University competitions.
 - c) Their achievement in sports is supported by continuous participation in sports in the same discipline.

- d) During sports trials, if the performance of the candidate is not satisfactory the candidate can be rejected.
5. Sports trials will be conducted on the university grounds in July every year. Trials of students from other states will be conducted upon their joining the university.
 6. For Athletic Trials, all events which are approved by AIU will be conducted.
 7. All the students admitted under this category will attend the ground.
 8. In the case of individual sports disciplines position in the individual event will be considered for gradation and not the position of the team.
 9. When a student is going to participate in an Inter-University or National Competition he/ she should seek prior permission from the HOD/Dean of the individual College.
 10. In case a student does not attend the practice grounds or does not participate in the Inter-College and Inter-University Competitions on medical grounds, the medical certificate issued only by the university doctor will be accepted.
 11. University will take an undertaking from the students that they will attend ground regularly.

Gradation of Sports Certificates

The gradation for competitions other than Inter-University, Inter-College, and Inter-School will be considered provided these are recognized by the IOC, IOA, MYAS, and National Sports Federations.

Category – A

- i) Position or participation in any official International competitions recognized by IOA, MYAS, FISU, or National Sports Federations/ Associations of the concerned games.
- ii) Getting any of the first three positions in Senior National/ Federation cup/ All India Inter University competitions/ Khelo India University games.
- iii) Getting any of the first three positions in Junior National/ SGFI National School games/ Youth National/ Khelo India Youth Games.

Category – B

- i) Getting any of the first three positions in Zonal Inter-University competitions.
- ii) All India Inter University/ Khelo India University games Participation.
- iii) Sr/Jr. National/ SGFI participation.

Category – C

- i) Getting any of the first three positions in Senior state competitions.
- ii) Getting any of the first three positions in Junior state/ School state competitions.
- iii) Getting any of the first three positions in the University 'B' Division competitions.
- iv) Position or participation in CBSE (KVS) national games.

Note: A student without a sports certificate but having an outstanding performance during the trials can be considered for admission. The category will be decided based on his/her performance.

The following benefits will be given to the sportspersons

Category – A

- i) Full fee waiver (Tuition fee, Admission fee, and Examination fee)
- ii) Free stay
- iii) Free Food nutritious diet
- iv) Food supplements worth Rs. 100/- per day (Milk, Juice/ Fruits)

Category – B

- i) 70% fee waiver in tuition fee and Admission fees. Free Stay, free food & normal diet.

Category – C

- i) 40% Fee concession in Tuition fee only

Note: - The cases for the above concessions are to be routed through Director Sports.

Academic Benefits to Sportspersons

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| i) International Participants | : | 35% |
| ii) All India Inter University/ Khelo India University Games/ National position holders | : | 30% |
| iii) Zonal University Games position holders | : | 25% |
| iv) All India Inter University/ Khelo India University Games/ Zonal University Games/ National participation: | : | 20% |
| v) State level position holders | : | 10% |

Note:

- i) The students shall be provided academic benefits based on the above-mentioned criteria in each program over and above their actual marks obtained in the Exam.
- ii) In case a candidate misses his/her exam due to participation in Sports camps or competitions then an extra chance shall be provided without charging any fee.

Off Campus Sportspersons

1. Off-campus outstanding sportspersons who are getting training at various centers of the country such as SAI centers, centers of excellence, sss or any public or private academies are allowed to stay at their training centers.
2. These sportspersons will be considered on duty and they will be entitled to duty leave and all other benefits of regular students.
3. D.A. will be given as under:
 - a) International Medalists: Rs. 500/- per head/ per day
 - b) International Participants: Rs. 425/- per head / per day
 - c) Senior National/ All India Inter University/ Khelo India University Games
 - Gold Medalists: Rs. 400/- per head/ per day
 - Silver Medalists: Rs. 350/- per head/ per day
 - Bronze Medalists: Rs. 300/- per head/ per day
 - d) Junior National/ School National (SGFI)
Khelo India Youth Games/ Youth National
 - Gold Medalists: Rs. 300/- per head/ per day
 - Silver Medalists: Rs. 250/- per head/ per day
 - Bronze Medalists: Rs. 200/- per head/ per day
