Minutes of 11th Meeting of IQAC held on 10th May, 2021

Item No. 1	Welcome address and Introduction Dr. Neelam Grewal, Vice-Chancellor and the Chairman of IQAC welcomed all the members to the meeting.
Item No. 2	Confirmation of the minutes of 10th meeting of IQAC The minutes of the 10 th meeting of IQAC on 9 th February, 2021 which were circulated to the members and approved by the Chairman IQAC as no comments were received from any quarter.
Item No. 3	Action taken on points discussed in meeting of IQAC The Feedback survey for University students was conducted. A brief report was presented by Dean Academics. The departments were directed to expedite the process of encouragement of publications in their research departments.


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Item No. 4	Finalization of Vision, Mission and Core Values of University <p>A good discussion was held on Vision & Mission after making all suggestions on Vision, Mission & Core Values for university were finalized. The Chairman directed Dean Academics to put up on the website.</p>
Item No. 5	Implement Learning Management System (LMS) <p>Members discussed the phased enactment of Learning Management System (LMS) in the Guru Kashi University. The progress and modules activated and executed were highlighted. The members discussed the prerequisites of supplementary modules to be implemented for better engagement, provide flexibility, for upgrading of eLearning content, put into practice learner-centric methodologies to increase participative learning and self-learning by students.</p>
Item No. 6	Academic & Administrative Audit <p>Audits are the backbone of governance in any academic institution. GKU has always endeavored for imparting quality education and elite infrastructure to its staff and students to provide an ambience of excellence. Members discussed and reviewed administrative audit of the University for the assessment of policies and its strategic plans academic (apropos their teaching, learning, evaluation, research and extension activities) audit to evaluate the proficiency, productivity and efficacy of all faculties of the university, which is a continuous practice in the University and serves as quality indicator framework.</p>
Item No. 7	Bio Gas Plant <p>University has always displayed its concern for social responsibility by adopting environment-friendly practices. In addition to its existing facilities like STP, energy conservation, rain water harvesting, the members were apprised that University has got installed Bio Gas Plant for waste recycling. The chairman appreciated and directed for adopting such environment friendly measures.</p>
Item No. 8	Campus to Corporate <p>The Committee members reviewed the placement status of the University and discussed about measures to provide more exposure about industry to its students. The Committee decided to conduct various activities under the events "Campus to Corporate" to provide a platform to students where student can interact with industry experts and groom themselves accordingly.</p>
Item No. 9	NAD Cell <p>The committee was apprised of the need to establish NAD cell in accordance with the requirements of e-governance policy of the Government. The process will also add to the facilitation of students to access their documents anywhere and anytime. The directions were issued to establish NAD cell in the university.</p>
