**Minutes of 1<sup>st</sup> Meeting of IQAC, 20 January, 2017**

Item No. 1	<b>Welcome Address and Introduction</b>  Dr. B. S. Dhaliwal, Vice-Chancellor and Chairman of IQAC welcomed all the members. He briefly introduced the new members to the House.

<b>Item No. 3</b>	<b>Discussion on Expectations, Goals and Functioning of Internal Quality Assurance Cell</b>  The NAAC guidelines for an Internal Quality Assurance Cell were shared by Director IQAC. The participants discussed the functioning of the IQAC. It was briefed that the primary objective of IQAC was to promote, inculcate and facilitate a culture of excellence and quality in the University in all its domains. The main function of IQAC is to suggest and implement quality benchmark for academic, research and administrative activities of the GKU. The IQAC Cell of University shall also conduct frequent workshops and seminars to provide guidance and disseminate various quality parameters to University Faculty and Students. It also motivates all concerned to work for excellence.
<b>Item No. 4</b>	<b>Quality Evaluation Approaches with Regard to Faculty &amp; Students</b>  The existing process of student evaluation and faculty evaluation in the university was discussed and it was decided to conduct feedback survey for the same from various quarters including stakeholders.
<b>Item No. 5</b>	<b>Discussion on Research Publications</b>  The members suggested that thrust needs to be given on research-by-research scholars and faculty to produce quality research papers.  As per UGC guidelines, to assess the quality of research publications, University shall benchmark research journals publishing high quality research papers.  It was decided that research paper publications be encouraged among the faculty members and necessary guidelines be provided for selecting the high impact quality journal.  The IQAC will organize seminars & FDPs by experts to motivate faculty and research scholars to write and produce quality research papers.
<b>Item No. 6</b>	<b>Regarding Course Curriculum Development</b>  The members suggested to follow necessary guidelines for curriculum development and implementation as per NAAC requirements.
<b>Item No. 7</b>	<b>Establishment of Students Interaction Cell (SIC)</b>  The committee members discussed the need of the students for a dedicated facilitation counter to address their grievances. Accordingly, the directions were issued to establish a dedicated SIC cell in the University.
