

Appointment, Terms & Conditions of Service and Powers and Functions of the Dean Student Welfare

In pursuance of the provisions of subsection (vi) of Section 6 of the Act, Dean Student Welfare may be appointed by the Vice-Chancellor, from amongst teachers of the University or who has been teacher of any other University not be below the rank of Professor or with the equivalent research and industrial experience, on the recommendations of the Selection Committee chaired by the Vice-Chancellor and confirmed by the Chancellor.

When the office of the Dean Student Welfare is vacant or when the Dean Student Welfare is by reason of illness or absence or any other cause, unable to perform the duties of his office, the duties of the office shall be performed by such person as the Vice-Chancellor may appoint for the purpose

Powers and Functions of Dean Student Welfare

Dean Student Welfare will be whole time salaried officer of the University. The Dean Student Welfare shall be directly responsible to the Vice-Chancellor and shall have the following duties:

- a) Responsible for campus discipline of the students and deal with all matters pertaining to discipline among the university students & devise ways and means for their wellbeing.
- b) Management and coordinate with the hostel wardens to ensure quality boarding and lodging facility provided to the students in the university campus.
- c) Chairperson of the Anti-Ragging Committee to ensure ragging free campus for the students of the university.
- d) Encourage healthy living and lively positive relationships among students and the campus community.
- e) Shall be responsible for planning and management of various student co- and extra-curricular activities and the physical education programme in the university including those pertaining to NCC and NSS.
- f) to devise ways and means for promoting the wellbeing of the University students social, moral and emotional values inculcating among them, regard for great ideas, like loyalty to country, devotion to duty and

pursuit of truth and achieving excellence in studies and other co-curricular activities and sports, etc;.

- g) To perform such other duties as may be entrusted to him/her by the Vice-Chancellor from time to time
